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**Please note that only students that have completed their requirements for May will receive their diploma at the May graduation ceremony. August and December graduates will receive their diplomas following the respective term. Please note that diplomas will not be conferred on the May graduation date for any of the following reasons:** incomplete grades, incomplete internship hours, or continued summer coursework. After the necessary requirements have been completed, your degree will be conferred on the next graduation date. Your diploma will not be released to you at graduation if your professor has not submitted your grades or if you have an unpaid debt owed to the institution. You will receive your diploma after these issues have been resolved.

**Cost Information:** The established Graduation Fee is \$150 for all students. A late fee of \$75 will be charged if a student applies for graduation after the **graduation application deadline of April 15, 2020**. Students who make changes to their degree or certificate on their submitted graduation application after November 1, 2020 will also be charged a \$75 late fee to help defray costs of updating diplomas and other graduation costs incurred as a result of the change(s). If a student must change their graduation date due to lacking enough clinical internship hours in the specified timeframe or a result of additional required coursework, no late fee will be assessed in these situations.
