Richmont Graduate University acknowledges it signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement on September 15, 2020, and gives the assurance that RGU intends to use no less than 50% of the funds received under section 18004(a)(3) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

- 1. The total amount of funds RGU received on September 28, 2020 from the U.S. Department of Education for distribution to students is \$218,672.00
- 2. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under section 18004(a)(3) of the CARES Act as of March 31, 2021 is \$218,672.00.
- 3. The estimated number of RGU students eligible to participate in programs under section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under section 18004(a)(3) of the CARES ACT is 226.
- 4. The total number of students who received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under section 18004(a)(3) of the CARES Act was 226.
- 5. In addition to RGU students applying for Student Emergency CARES grants RGU will award all eligible students a flat amount each semester until the funds are depleted.
